

## **Roles and Responsibilities for Killay Community Councillors.**

Community Councillors are all voluntary and they have to abide by the City and County of Swansea's Code of Conduct which they will be asked to sign up to when they become Community Councillors.

The meetings take place on the 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of every month (except December when there is no meeting) at 7 15pm in the Killay Information Centre.

The Community Council is a statutory consultee on all Planning Applications for the area.

There are other committees for example :- Footpaths, Entertainments etc. and you are expected to be on at least one. They meet as required.

The Community Council is responsible for running the Killay Information and Tourist Centre and Councillors are expected to help out.

They also have responsibility for the flower beds in the precinct and have entered the Community Council in the Swansea in Bloom contest getting gold twice.

The Entertainments committee run the Summer Fun Day and the very popular Christmas Lights and Grotto.
